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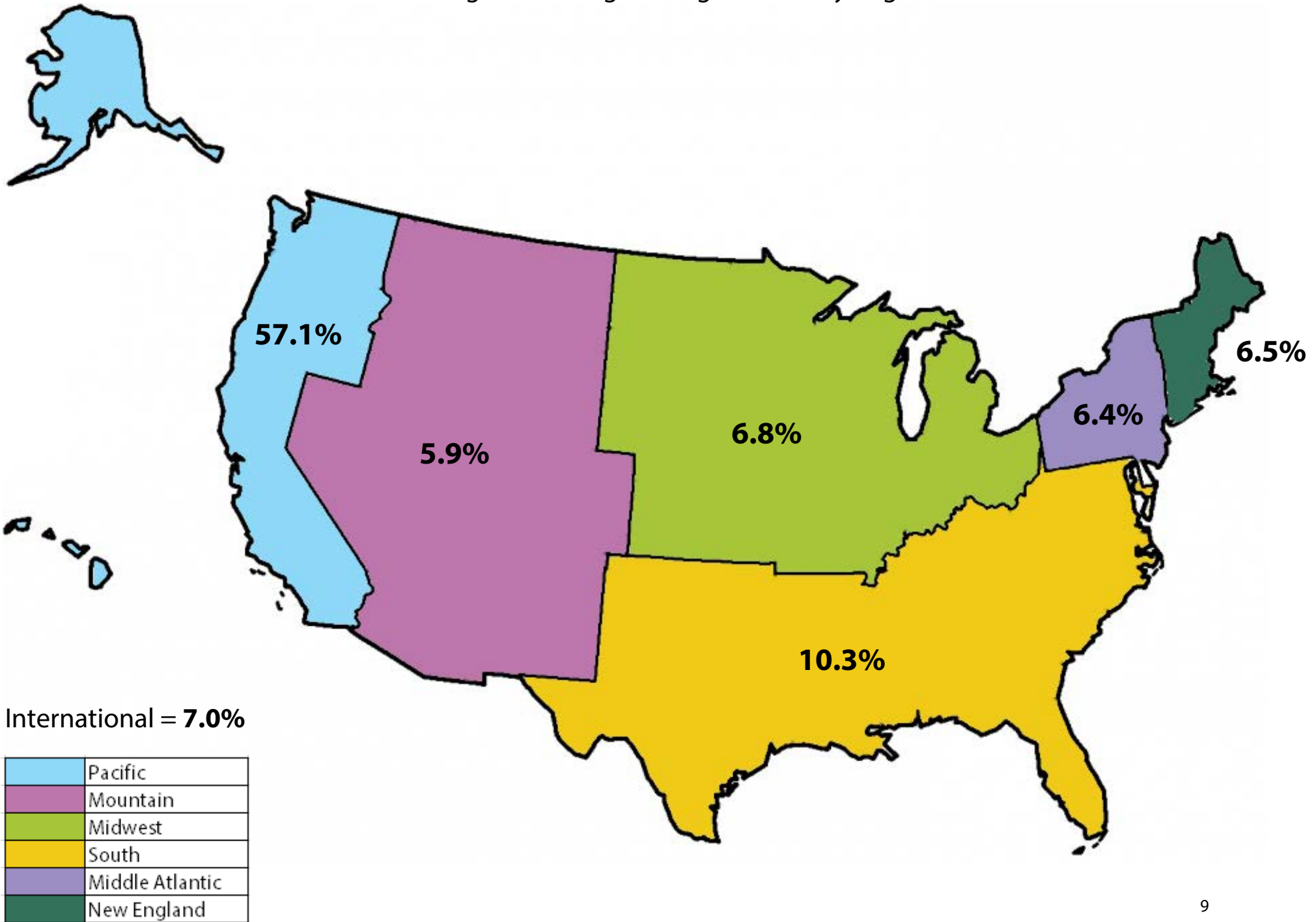

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Degree-Seeking Undergraduates by Region



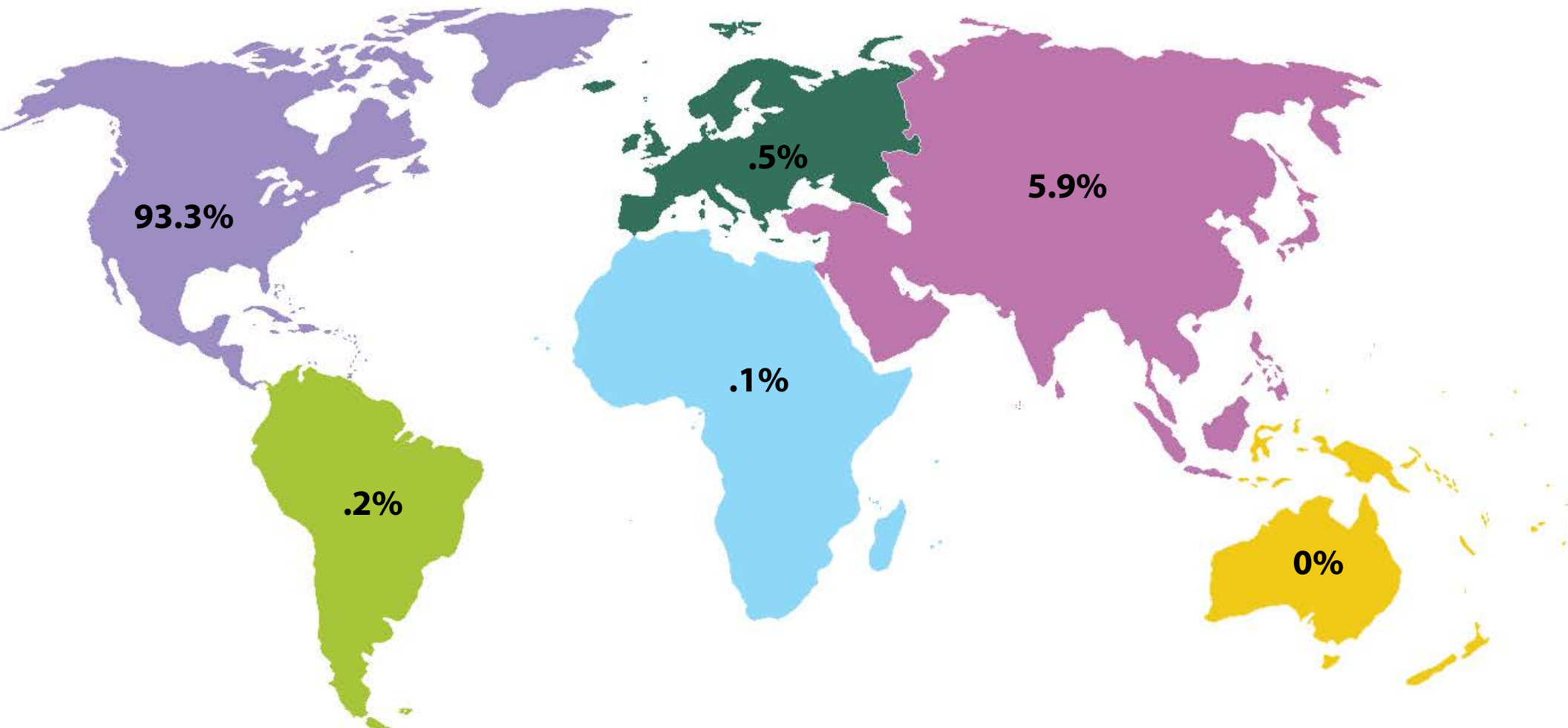
Fall 2017 Degree-Seeking Undergraduates by Continent






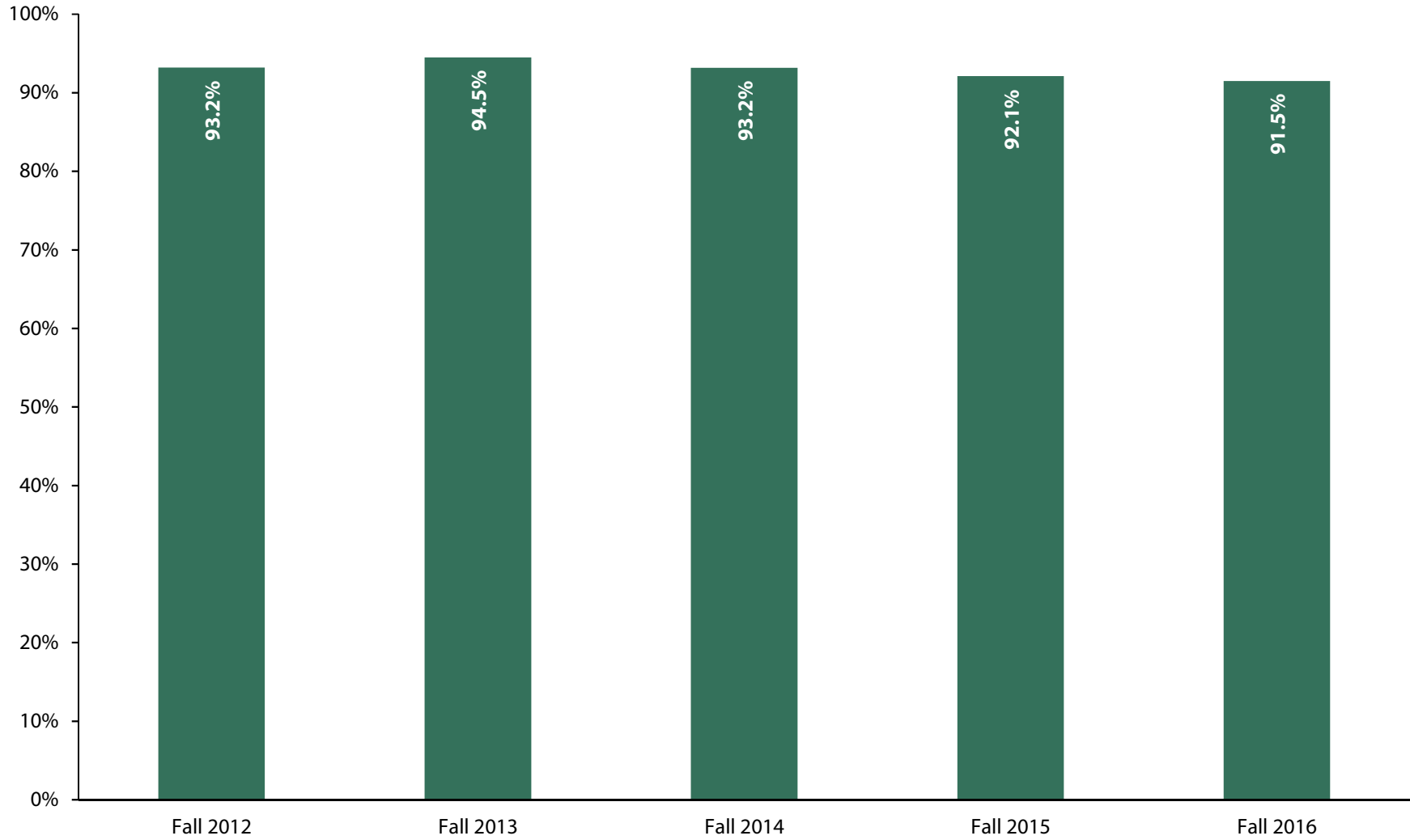

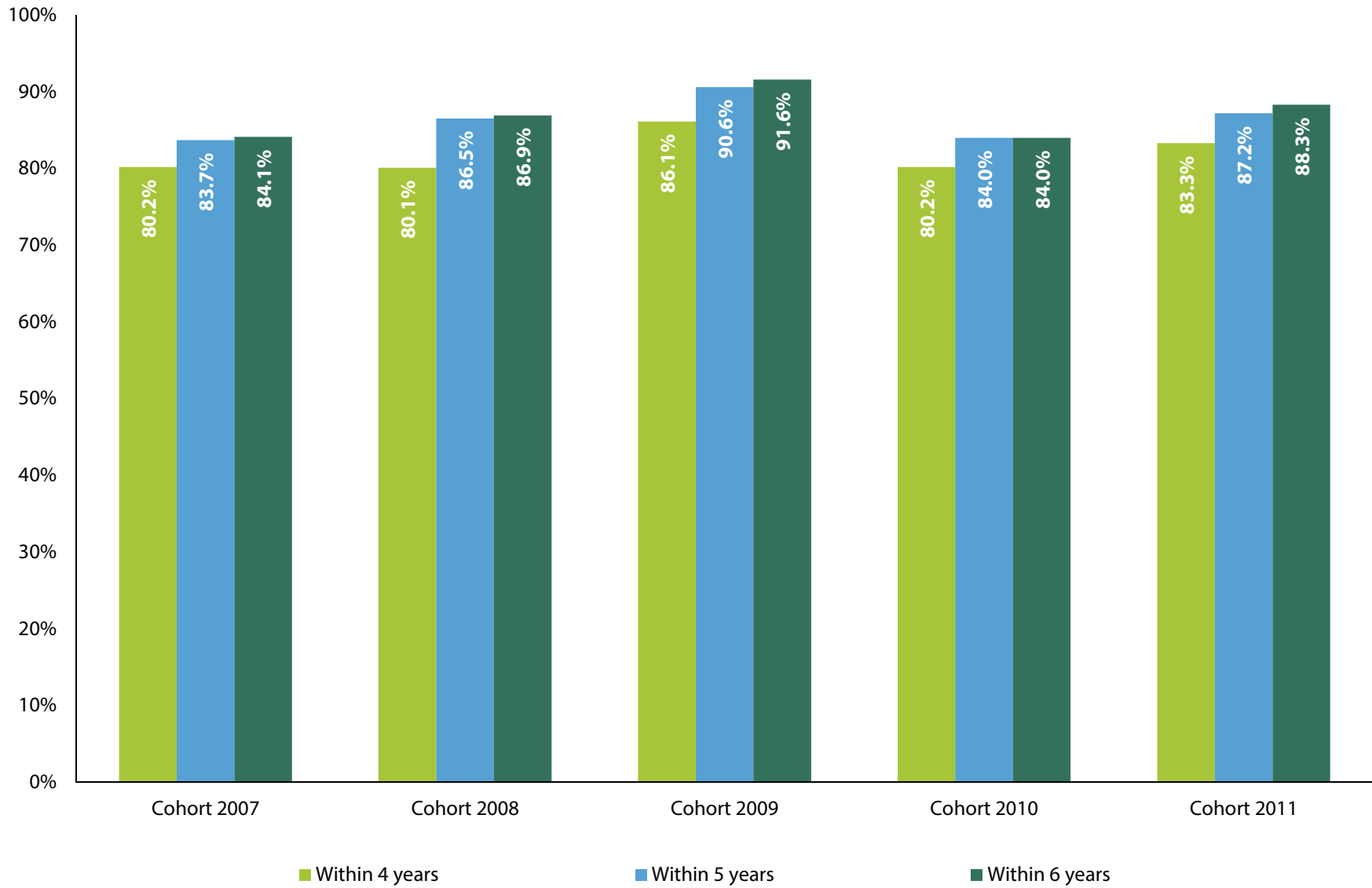

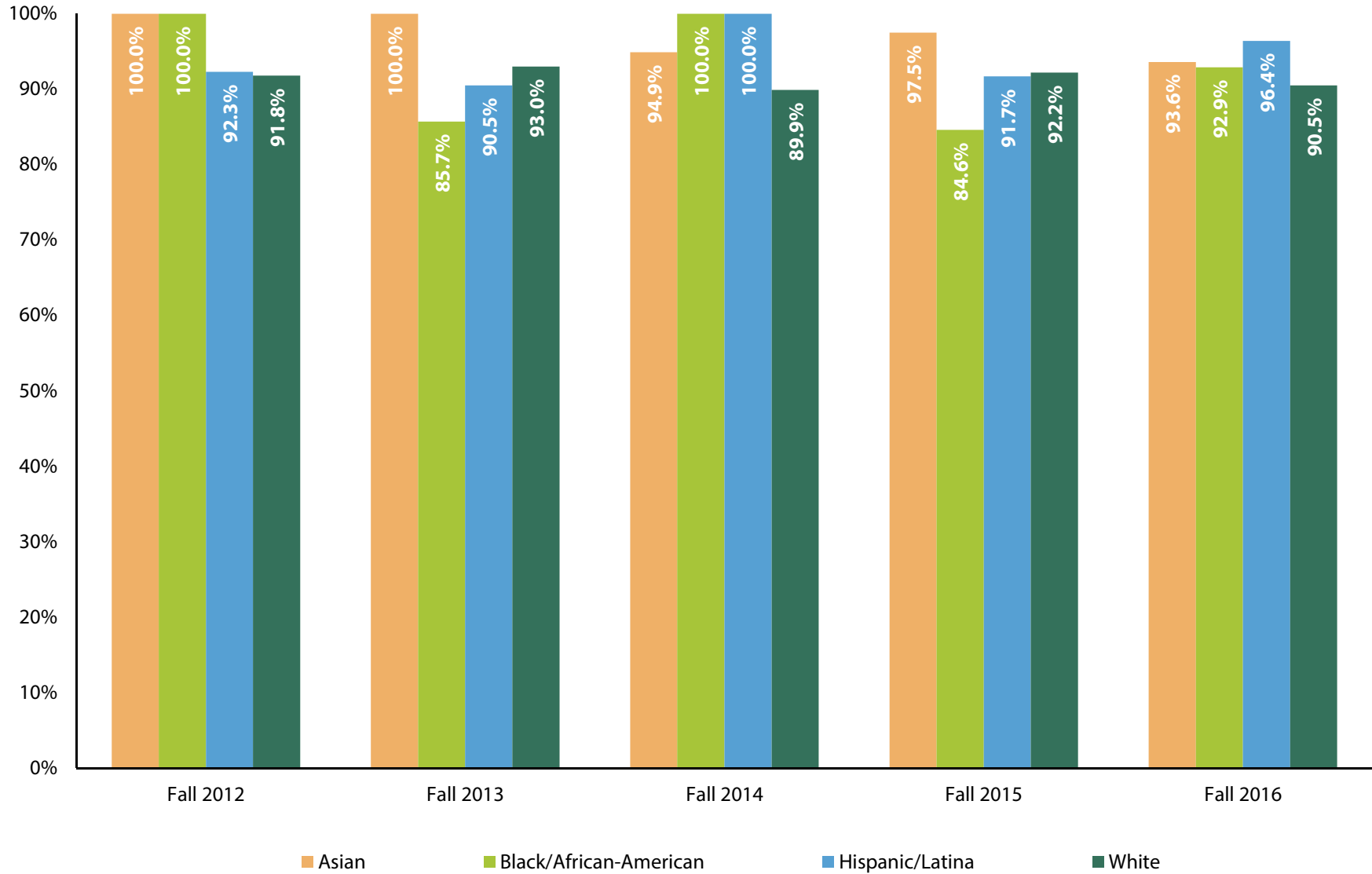

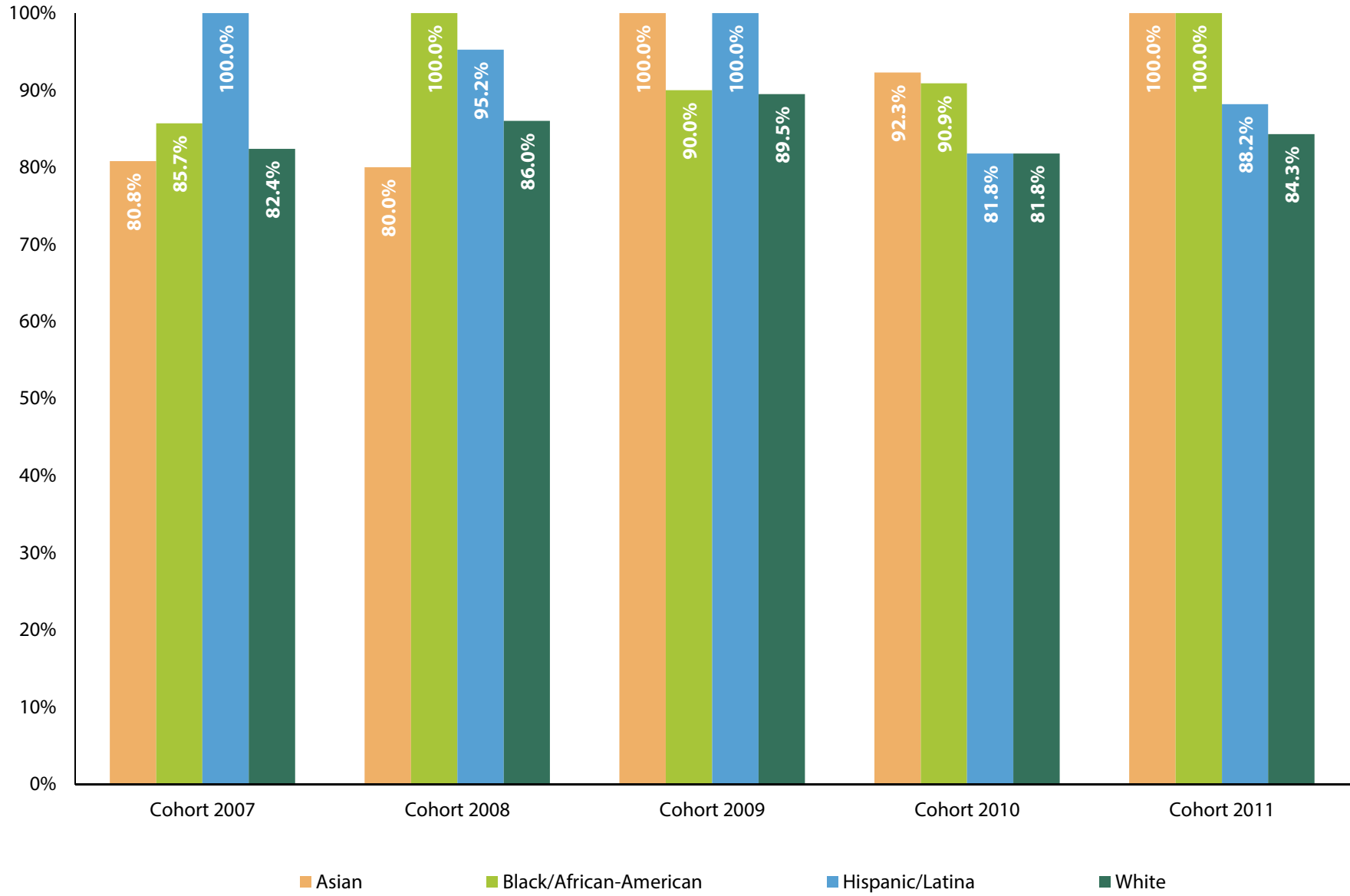
