

Spring 2018 Music Applied Lessons Auditions

Don't miss your opportunity to participate in private/group voice, keyboard, and chamber music lessons. Sign up for an audition time during the first week of classes for spring 2018.

Sign up for an audition/interview time at any time of day at the Scripps College Performing Arts Center (by Garrison Theater, 241 E. 10th Street), where audition schedules are posted on the wall of the Music Library prior to the first week of classes.

At the audition, we ask students to sing or play at least one representative piece and tell us about their musical background. Vocalists are asked to bring sheet music for the accompanist. Beginners are also welcome and will use their audition time for a brief interview. Lessons (in most cases) are one half hour per week and count as a half course credit (1.5 credit at Harvey Mudd).
