## 01

Choose the top 5 issues most important to you in any upcoming election.

Read what the candidates have to say about these issues. Check out their websites.

## 03

Find four sources (two for each opposing viewpoint) for each of your issues as they relate to the candidates

## 04

Find your stance. How do your beliefs about your topics align with each candidate?

## 05

Make the call. (Then hold them to their word.)
