- Once you have attended all required session to complete a designated track, you will be invited to the celebration banquet and presented with a certificate of completion.
- You are allowed to petition for up to 2 events outside the designated opportunities to count towards the required 8. You will need a staff approval from the office that oversees your track (TFH staff for Health & Wellness Track, or SCORE staff for Community Engagement) and will need to your petition form signed. The form can be found on the Laspa website. Once approved, you will need to submit it to the Laspa office so that it can be added to the program tracking document.
