One of the hallmarks of the Claremont Colleges is a strong commitment to music and the performing arts. The **Joint Music Program of Claremont McKenna**, **Harvey Mudd, Pitzer, and Scripps Colleges** provides exciting performing opportunities in ensembles of critically recognized quality and musicianship. While these ensembles are comprised of a number of music majors, the majority of our students come from a variety of interests and majors, from science and math to the social sciences, arts, and humanities. Many Scripps students participate in an ensemble. The following Joint Music ensembles are 0.5 CR courses:

The Claremont Concert Choir (<u>http://www.jointmusicprogram.org/choirs</u> MUS 173JM, 0.5 CR) is an auditioned chorus performing *a cappella* and piano-accompanied literature from the renaissance to the present as well as major works of the 18<sup>th</sup> through 21<sup>st</sup> centuries with symphony orchestra. It regularly rehearses Mondays and Wednesdays from 7:00-8:30 p.m.

The Claremont Treble Singers (<a href="http://www.jointmusicprogram.org/choirs">http://www.jointmusicprogram.org/choirs</a> MUS 176JM, 0.5 CR) is an auditioned ensemble specializing in music for soprano and alto voices from the middle ages to the present, including contemporary compositions. The Treble Singers regularly rehearse Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30-6:45 p.m.

The Claremont Concert Orchestra (<a href="http://www.jointmusicprogram.org/orchestra">http://www.jointmusicprogram.org/orchestra</a> MUS 175JM, 1 CR) is a 50-70 member auditioned symphony orchestra specializing in major orchestral works of the 18<sup>th</sup> through 21<sup>st</sup> centuries. Besides having its own concert series, it annually performs with the Choirs. The Claremont Concert Orchestra regularly rehearses Monday and Wednesday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. The preparation process for each concert includes frequent sectionals with expert coaches from the greater Los Angeles area.

Plans for the concert season are well underway. In November, the Claremont Concert Choir and Claremont Treble Singers will perform a concert together with guest conductor Anna Nora from Finland. In December, the choirs and orchestra will join forces to present the monumental Ninth Symphony ("Choral Symphony") by Beethoven. Other works to be performed by the Claremont Concert Orchestra in 2023-24 include Dvorak's Eighth Symphony and Brahms' Violin Concerto featuring one of our own students. The accomplishments of these ensembles are many, and we want you to join with us and your student colleagues from your own and other colleges in these highly regarded groups to create these magnificent works of musical art.

Joint Music Program ensemble **auditions** are held in late August.
