

Voting Guide for San Bernardino County

For the November 3, 2020 Election

Register to vote - Deadline is Monday, October 19, 2020

Online - Go to registertovote.ca.gov.

By Mail - Go to registertovote.ca.gov and request a paper registration form.

In Person - Pick up a voter registration application, visit SBCountyElections.com.

Same Day/Late - After October 19 new registrants will be issued a provisional ballot.

What You'll Need*

California Driver's License or Identification Card
Last four digits of your social security number

Find Your Polling Place

Go plan.lavote.net to using the Polling Place Locator or Call (800) 881-VOTE or (909) 387-8300.

* While California does not require voters to show ID at the polls if they have voted before, it is wise to bring the same ID to the polls that you used when you registered in case of mishap.

Vote by Mail

Every active registered voter will receive a mail ballot which will be delivered by the USPS beginning October 5th. You can either mail the ballot or drop it off. Find a drop off location using SBC's Ballot Drop-Off Locator website. Otherwise there are also in-person polling places.

Vote in Person

Use SBC's Polling Place Locator website and search by city. Polling places will be open from Saturday, October 31st through Tuesday November 3rd.

Important Dates

- Vote-by-mail ballot mailing begins
 - October 5
- Last Day to Register to Vote Online or by Mail
 - October 19
- Early Vote Sites Open
 - October 31

Last Day to Postmark Mail-In Ballots is Election Day, November 3!
